Washington, D.C., January 31, 2011 –

Transparency International-USA (TI-USA) expressed profound concern that the UK Government will, once again, delay publication of its guidance to companies on “adequate procedures” under the UK Bribery Act and, thus, postpone implementation of the Act. Given years of delay already, along with rumors that resources for enforcement will be cut and the issue given a lower priority, the Government’s announcement today that publication would follow “in due course” raises serious questions about its political will. TI-UK has protested strongly, calling the delay “disastrous news.” TI-USA protested to the OECD and urged the U.S. Government to demarche the UK to move forward promptly. TI chapters in other G7 countries are seeking action by their governments. It is time for the UK Government to live up to its obligations and take action.
