Lani Cossette is responsible for promoting Transparency International USA's (TI-USA) anti-corruption agenda in the development assistance arena, working with the TI network and external constituencies and advocates their adoption by the multilateral and bilateral development agencies. Ms. Cossette works with the multilateral development agencies, the US Administration, Congress, the private sector, other non-governmental organizations, and with think tanks and academic institutions.

Ms. Cossette was formerly a consultant to the World Bank Group Integrity Vice Presidency and its predecessor entity. She investigated allegations of fraud and corruption in World Bank funded development projects and analyzed evidence to prepare cases for internal sanctions procedures and referrals to foreign governments. Ms. Cossette has also been an attorney with Zuckerman Spaeder, LLP and Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher, LLP, a corporate investigator with PricewaterhouseCoopers and Control Risks Group, and a Washington Correspondent for the Japanese newspaper, the Yomiuri Shimbun.

Ms. Cossette received her J.D. from George Washington University Law School and a B.S. from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service.
