The position requires frequent interaction with multilateral and bilateral development agencies, US government aid agencies, and TI chapters and other non-governmental organizations, as well as with media, think tanks and academic institutions. The policy director is responsible for developing position papers, building strategic partnerships and advocacy campaigns, and mobilizing technical expertise. Position involves white papers, testimony, speeches, newsletters, press releases, op-eds, and website content.

The position requires a minimum of six years of experience in field related to international development and a relevant graduate degree. Excellent writing and communications skills are essential. USAID, World Bank or other MDB experience and expertise in corruption, collusion and fraud in procurement a plus. Fast-paced, lean organization values flexibility, independence and collegiality.
